

At the very water's edge, this unique 17th century inn is reputed to have been the haunt of local French brandy smugglers for many years.

Today, Portloe currently harbours two full-time working fishing vessels; the Jasmine and Katy Lil, both of which fish for crab and lobster in Veryan and Gerrans Bay.



## How to Reach The Lugger Hotel

### By Road

Travel via the M5 motorway and A30 or A38; turn off the A390 St Austell to Truro road on to the B3287 to Tregony, then take the A3078 (St Mawes road) and after 2 miles fork left for Veryan and Portloe, turning left at the T-junction for Portloe. There is a private hotel car park adjacent to the property exclusively for guests.

### By Rail

There are regular train services from London Paddington to Truro. We can arrange for a taxi to meet you or provide car hire facilities. Truro is approximately 25 minutes from the hotel.

### By Air

Flights to Newquay Airport are available from London Gatwick, East Midlands, Edinburgh and Manchester. We can arrange for a taxi to meet you or provide car hire facilities. The airport is approximately 35 minutes from the hotel.
